



Parent View October 2015

Thank you to all parents for sharing your view of the school in our Parent View Questionnaire at the parent consultations in October. Your feedback is essential for providing us with a different perspective on the effectiveness of the policies that we have in place at our school. I am delighted to report to you that for the second year running we have 83% of the families represented in our Parent View – a record for the second year running. This high-level of response enables us to respond to your views and continue to drive the school forward positively.

Here is a summary of the results.

This school deals effectively with bullying	93%	7%	31% (most stated that this statement was not applicable for them)

This school responds well to any concerns I raise	95%	5%	16% (most stated that this statement was not applicable for them)
I receive valuable information from the school about my child's progress	96%	4%	6%
Would you recommend this school to another parent	98%	2%	4%
